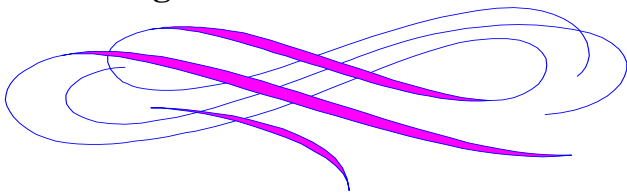

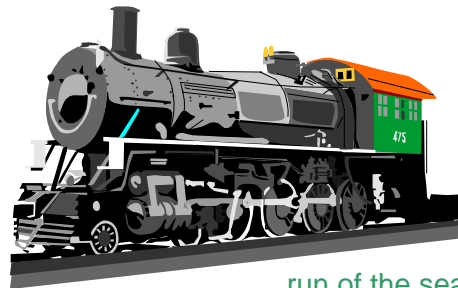
To My Brothers in Christ,

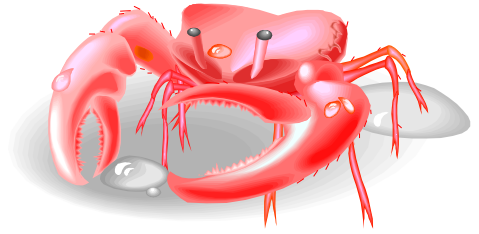

Proper Protocol for KC Meetings

Brother Knights:

In our last Knight Letter, I talked primarily on the use of the gavel, while the meeting is in session.

I thought that we should continue on this subject, because I noticed a little confusion at time, at the start of the last meeting.

1. The Grand Knight gives 1 rap to come to order and sit down.
2. Then we are given 4 raps to kneel in prayer.
3. Immediately after the prayer, we should hear 3 raps to stand for the salute to the flag which is lead by the warden.
4. Right after the flag salute, we should hear 1 rap for everyone to sit down.
5. Immediately after all sit down, our leader raps the gavel 2 times for all officers to stand for roll call.

As our recorder calls out the officers name and office that he holds, it is the **WARDENS RESPONSIBILITY** to report whether the officer is present or absent or excused.

One other thing that you should be aware of is:

When our dignitaries, District Deputy, Insurance Agent, etc. come into our Council Chambers early, before the meeting starts, they will mingle with us. Once everyone is settled down, our Grand Knight can acknowledge their presence. If they make their appearance after the meeting is in session, that is when our Grand Knight will rap the gavel for all to stand.

Brothers I hope I didn't confuse you too much.
