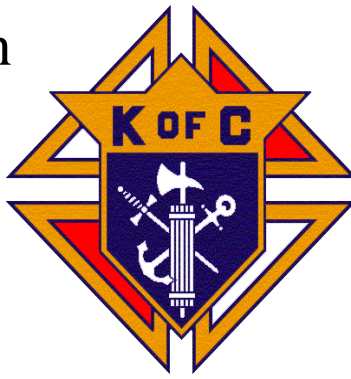

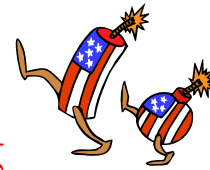
There is much more information coming at our next meeting - August 6th.
