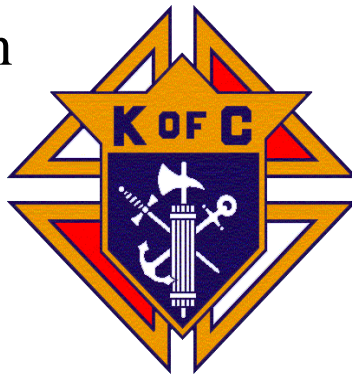

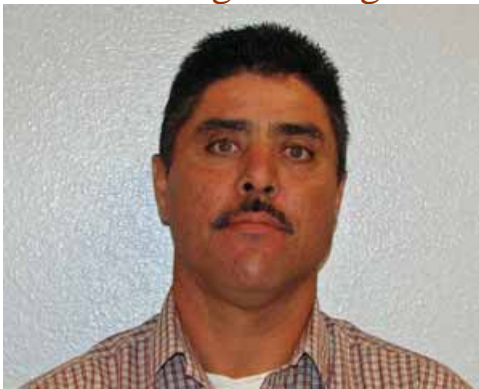

KofC Scholarship Information

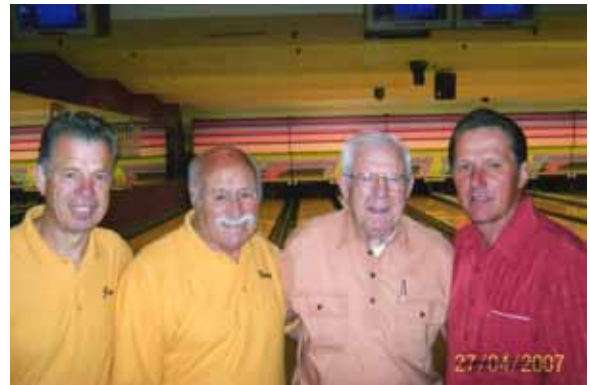

IN YOUR CORNER

“I already have insurance at work.”
